- * **DO NOT INCLUDE THE YAM LOGO IN THE DESIGN!**
- * Design must include the words: New Jersey or NJ in the design.
- * Design must be bold, 2-D, simple flat color design for reproduction.
- * No more than three(3) entries per school.
- * Please attach the Design Contest Label/Release to all works submitted.
- * Designs must be submitted & received no later than December 1, 2016 in FLAT packaging to: **Jenn Tiongson.**
