- Designs must be submitted on 12" by 18" paper, horizontal format
- Designs may be submitted digitally - in 12" by 18" horizontal format
- Designs must include the **YAM Theme** (in bold lettering):

ART CONNECTS US

- DO NOT INCLUDE THE YAM LOGO IN THE DESIGN!
- Design must include the words: **New Jersey or NJ**
- Design must be a bold, 2-D, simple, flat-color design for reproduction.
- No more than three (3) entries per teacher
- Designs must be submitted & received no later than **January 30, 2021 at 11:59 pm.**
